

**USEA AREA IV YOUNG RIDERS — 2009
NAJYRC OUTLINE OF ELIGIBILITY & INTENT**



USEA Area IV Young Riders applying for NAJYRC must complete and return ALL of the forms listed to the Area IV Coordinator on or before **May 15, 2009**, to be eligible for consideration.

- 2) 2009 North American Young Riders Championship Declaration of Intent to Ride
- 3) Selection Process for Area IV for the 2009 North American Young Riders Championship Three-Day Event
- 4) USEF Code of Conduct
- 5) USEA Code of Conduct
- 6) USEF Waiver

Additional Consideration

For riders going for NAJYRC or MidSouth teams it is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**: Young Rider camp at Lamplight Equestrian Center, July 15-18 with Area IV coach Jonathan Holling.

Mandatory outing for NAJYRC: . Otter Creek Horse Trials May 22-24, 2009 or Fox River Valley Horse Trials June 26-28, 2009
Riders may compete at a level below to a level above where they will run at NAJYRC. Riders unable to compete in the mandatory outing please refer to the "Selection Process for Area IV for the 2009 North American Young Riders Championship Three-Day Event" document for the process of submitting a special request for consideration.

Horses being considered for NAJYRC will be subject to mandatory veterinary evaluations at the conclusion of Otter Creek Horse Trials or Fox River Valley Horse Trial.

A final veterinary inspection will be performed at the end of Area IV Young Rider 2009 Camp.
